STEPHEN MINISTRY. Training Update

Please pray for our Stephen Ministers as they continue to enhance their caregiving skills. Here is what they are learning this week.

Session Four — Distinctively Christian Caring (Part 1)

This is the first of two sessions on distinctively Christian caring. Stephen Ministers explore the essentials of using their Christian faith in caring for another, drawing on the resources of prayer, witnessing, the Bible, forgiveness, blessings, and more.

An important motto of Stephen Ministry is "The Stephen Minister is the **caregiver**, and God is the **curegiver**." This training session underscores this Christ-centered focus for Stephen Ministers.

Session Five—Distinctively Christian Caring (Part 2)

This is the second of two sessions on this topic, as Stephen Ministers explore how Christian caregivers have something distinctive that they can offer that other caregivers cannot provide—God's unconditional love and forgiveness through Jesus Christ.

In this session our Stephen Ministers will specifically practice and discuss the use of prayer, confession and absolution, and the Bible in caregiving relationships.
