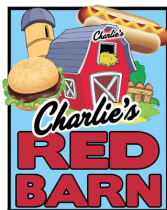

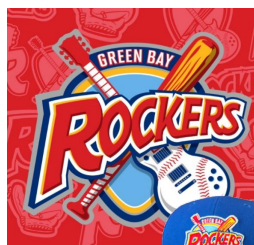
TEACHERS NEEDED
