We are asking for help to gather these supplies needed:

- (1) light-weight bath-size towel (20"x40" to 52"x 27")
- (2-3) bath-size bars of soap equaling 8-9 oz., any brand, in packaging; no mini or hotel-size bars
- (1) adult-size toothbrush in its original packaging
- (1) sturdy comb ... there are many types of hair texture, so no picks or fine-tooth combs; remove packaging.
- (1) metal nail clipper (file optional), remove packaging.

ZLCW SCHOOL KITS FOR LWR

ZLCW Board has decided to collect items for School Kits for Lutheran World Relief (LWR), to be sent in October. Education is a vital tool a community has for breaking the poverty cycle. Ensuring girls attend school, especially in places where their access is not a priority, has even stronger results. School Kits contain essential supplies to help children – and, in some cases, adults – continue learning in the face of serious obstacles. That learning leads to a better life for them, their families, and their communities.

Remember when collecting supplies for School Kits:

- Give new items only, and show the most tremendous respect and care for the recipient.
- Do not donate items with religious symbols, messages, or your congregation's name.
- Do not donate items decorated with a U.S. flag, patriotic or military symbols, or the armed forces, including camo.

Items needed in each School Kit include:

- (4) 70-80 sheet notebooks of wide- or college-ruled paper approximately 8"x10.5"; no loose-leaf paper.
- (1) 30-centimeter ruler, or a ruler with centimeters on one side and inches on the other
- (1) pencil sharpener
- (1) pair of blunt scissors (safety scissors with embedded steel blades work well)
- (5) unsharpened #2 pencils w/erasers; rubber band secured
- (5) black or blue pens (no gel ink); rubber band secured
- (1) box of 16 or 24 crayons
- (1) 2.5-inch eraser

A tote, next to the elevator, is provided to collect the items you bring in for this worthwhile cause. Thank you!


