JERUSALEM SESQUICENTENNIAL

In the next few weeks, we'll include inserts in the ZION Bulletin promoting the history of the **Jerusalem Church** in Lunds. Also, check out the nice display in the Narthex. We will share some history of the church which we hope you enjoy! In the 1860s, Norwegian settlers, driven by a desire for a better life, arrived in the Waukechon area. Their lives revolved around faith and family, and they held services and scripture readings in their humble homes, often lit by the warm glow of candlelight. In 1874, they erected a 20' x 28' church from hand-hewn logs, a testament to their unwavering faith and determination. Jerusalem Church in Lunds, Wis. still stands today. Over the years, the church has grown, adding a steeple, chancel, and bell. Despite the challenges, the Congregation remained devoted. In 1968, due to a lack of pastoral leadership, the Congregation closed, with eighty members joining ZION at that time. November 25, 2024, is the sesquicentennial anniversary of the Jerusalem Church (150 years)! To celebrate its history, a Sesquicentennial Anniversary Commemorative **Service** with speakers, storytelling, and music will be at the Jerusalem Church on Sun., Nov. 10 at 1 PM. All are welcome in honoring this landmark and the legacy of its early community. A cake and coffee reception to follow.

HONORING OUR SAINTS - NOV. 3

All Saints' Sunday will be celebrated on Sun., Nov. 3, honoring all saints who have left us since Nov. 1 last year. This special day lets us reflect on those who have shown compassion, courage, and humility. Honoring these saints connects us to the broader Christian community and inspires us to live faithfully.
